What is recollectionwisconsin.org?

A free resource for discovering state and local history materials from communities across Wisconsin, including photographs, postcards, maps, yearbooks, letters, diaries, books, articles, oral histories, and artifacts.

As of April 2013, recollectionwisconsin.org contains 194,758 historical resources from 195 digital collections provided by Wisconsin libraries, archives, museums, and historical societies. New content is added every month.

The Recollection Wisconsin program is sponsored by WiLS in partnership with the Milwaukee Public Library, UW-Madison, and the Wisconsin Historical Society. Funding is provided by a grant from the Nicholas Family Foundation.

Tips for searching and browsing

Use **Browse** (http://recollectionwisconsin.org/browse) to explore a single digital collection based on a specific topic, type of material or location.

Use **Basic Search** (http://recollectionwisconsin.org/search) to search across all collections by keyword, name or place.

Use **Guided Search** (http://recollectionwisconsin.org/guided-search) to search across all collections by phrase or other, more complex, searches.

Our search engine searches only the descriptive information provided by contributing partners, including titles of books and manuscripts, names of photographers and authors, subject terms, dates, and locations. To search the **full text** of books or other documents, open a specific item or collection and then run a second search within that item or collection.
